1. What is a diminutive noun?

A diminutive is a noun that describes a small version of another noun.

2. Take a German noun and make your own diminutive from it. der Elefant – das Elefäntchen

3. Below are 7 rules that can help you identify German neuter nouns. Go to an online dictionary (see Deutsche Schule Website/Resources for some dictionaries) and translate the nouns below into English. Then, determine the number of the rule that tells you that the (German) noun is neuter, that is, why it gets the article "das" in front of it.

Neuter nouns, which require "das" are:

(1) all diminutive nouns, that is, nouns that end in -chen or -lein

- (2) all nouns formed from an infinitive
- (3) most nouns ending in -nis, but not all(!)
- (4) <u>all</u> metals
- (5) most nouns ending in -ment
- (6) almost all nouns ending in -tel (for example, all fractions)
- (7) <u>all</u> nouns ending in -tum, -um
