

German Nouns definite articles (der, die, das) vs indefinite articles (ein, eine)

Definite male and neuter articles (**der/das**) correspond with indefinite **ein**.

Definite female article **die** corresponds with indefinite **eine**.

Below, write the definite article, the appropriate rule to determine the gender of the German word, the German word with the appropriate indefinite article, and the translation:

der Juli – months, weekdays or seasons are male – ein Juli – a July
