A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PRESIDENT

Liebe Mitglieder - Dear Members,

Every year in the month of January it is the President's duty to report to the General Membership the "state of the organization".

Once again, I am pleased to report that we are financially sound in part, to another successful Oktoberfest.

Projects completed this year include:

- A. resurfacing and striping of the parking lot, allotting more handicapped parking as well as resurfacing the driveway of both rental houses
- B. A new metal roof installed over the back entrance
- C. Oktoberfest storage shed relocated to be parallel with other storage shed, leaving a 12 foot space between the two, in anticipation of putting an additional roof between the two sheds, to store the Oktoberfest stage supports

- D. Purchase and installation of a deep fat fryer in the kitchen, to help increase the variety of food offered
- E. Installation and implementation of the Keyless Entry system.

Improvements on the calendar for 2012 include:

- A. Installation of Fire Protection System if approved by the General Membership,
- B. Increase much needed storage space,
- C. Install roof between the two Oktoberfest sheds,
- D. Installation of a metal roof on the side of the building, where Oktoberfest grilling stations reside
- E. Investigate the renovation of the Men's/Ladies Room at the back of the Deutsche Halle.

I have formed two new committees this year as follows:

CONSTITUTION COMMITTEE

I formed this committee to review the DSB Constitution as the last review was over 10 years ago and I feel that some areas are unclear and in general needs to be updated, as well as officers job descriptions need to reflect the "sign of the times" and need to be updated as well.

FINANCE COMMITTEE

The role of this committee is primarily to provide financial oversight for this organization. I have requested their first task include financial planning and the creation and monitoring of internal controls and accountability policies. An emphasis will be placed on developing procedures and accountability especially for the bar areas.

They will help develop SOP's and these will be the permanent guidelines for any officer to follow as this is greatly needed. We are successful when many cultural organizations have gone by the wayside and to remain that way, our club needs to be run as a business and these procedures will help to ensure that we do so.

As you know, we depend on your volunteerism to help with the smaller tasks which in turn enables us to go forth with the more costly projects. All of you have a talent that the DSB can benefit from, please don't hesitate to use it.

If we all do a little – together we can accomplish a lot!


