A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PRESIDENT

Liebe Mitglieder - Dear Members,

As of May 1, 2012 the Delaware Saengerbund will be a smoke free facility, in accordance with the Clean Indoor Air Act as mandated by the Delaware Department of Health and Human Services.

The Board of Directors was informed of our non-compliance of Title 16, Chapter 29, Par. 99107.5 which provides the definition of a "private club" under this regulation. Smoking is prohibited in accordance with this rule as we do not meet all the criteria. To qualify as a "private club" and allow smoking we cannot advertise to the general public, i.e. the Oktoberfest, Ladies Bazaar and other venues listed on our web site. To eliminate this advertising for the benefit of smoking is a financial disaster to this organization as we greatly depend on these activities to run our facility.

We supplied our background to the DHHS and we were advised that we do not qualify as a "private club" under this ruling and were told that smoking is prohibited in our club facility. An environmental lawyer was contacted as well and the advice was the same, smoking is prohibited.

This was a difficult task for your Board of Directors as we had to make a decision that will benefit all our members, not just a few. We realize we have a faction of members that smoke, and recognize the contributions they have made to our organization as well. With this in mind, The Board of Directors has approved to provide a gazebo and restaurant style outdoor heater to accommodate our smoking members.

Change is difficult for all of us and it is a price we pay for our ever increasing membership however, our facility and food has not changed, your friends are here and the beer is still cold. I encourage all of you to participate in the Gemütlichkeit that only the German culture can provide.

Our actions and inactions continually affect the people around us, as well as our own lives. We all make a difference every day – by what we say, what we do and by what we do not do. I hope you will work with us and help to make this club a great success for the welfare of all.


