# Special Event Notice: GERMAN NAVAL SHIP TO VISIT BALTIMORE

A German naval ship, the Fregatte "**Hessen**" will come to Baltimore in June as part of an international maritime festival that will launch Maryland's three-year War of 1812 bicentennial commemorations.

The "**Hessen**" is one of the newest and largest ships of the Deutsche Marine. Put into service in 2006, she has a crew of about 250 sailors and officers. It will be berthed in North Locust Point with shuttle bus service from the M&T stadium parking lot.
