DSB History: Enzian Volkstanzgruppe des Delaware Sangerbunds

The idea of having a Volkstanzgruppe started in 1955. Two members sent away for a Volkstanz instruction book "Bristoler Tanzbuch", but the idea dwindled when their husbands were not willing to join in. It was not until fifteen years later the Enzian Volkstanzgruppe came to be.

In 1968, Margot and Richard Trager, Ingeborg and George Keith, Helga and Karl-Heinz Schulz, and Tom and Gisela Yost, founded the Enzian Volkstanzgruppe. None of which had any prior folk dancing knowledge.

With the Tanzbuch in hand, the first dance they learned was a Landler. Music for the dance came from a record with a song titled "Gebirgskinder Landler". Practices took place in the Bauernstube. This dance has since become the groups Ehrentanz. It was first performed in October 1968 during the Sangerbund's Oktoberfest, held at the Wilmington Turn-Verein.

In 1969 the next phase of construction began on the DSB property. The 60 by 60 Deutsche Halle was erected, providing seating for 300 people. As the DSB Board of Directors put together a yearly calendar, it was then said that the Enzian Volkstanzgruppe will have the first dance of the fall season. To this day, the group still celebrates its Stiftungsfest as the first fall dance of the Delaware Sangerbund. This year we will celebrate 45 years.

Dieser Brauch ist in einigen Gegenden auch als "Pfungstochse oder "Palmesel" { am Palmsonntag} bekannt. Der Brauch geht auf vorchristliche Zeiten zurück und war ursprünglich ein Fruchtbarkeitsritual, wobei die Befruchtung der Erde nach dem Winter gefeiert wurde.

This term applies to that person which on Pentecost Sunday is the last to get up in a family. Similar terms, such as "Pfungstox" or "Palmdonkey' on Palm Sunday, are found in various geographical areas.
