German Recipe of the month

Sauerkraut in Lager

Sauerkraut (Kissling's) 2 pounds (1bag)

2 bottles of dark lager 24 ounce nitrate free smoked bacon 5 slices

medium onion chopped (size of a small apple) cumin 1/4 teaspoon to taste

juniper berries 2-4 clover 1-2

Bay leaf just a tiny piece, not the whole leaf since it will overpower all the other flavors

- 1) Cut up bacon in small cubes and sauté' in medium pan
- 2) add chopped onion and sauté' until golden
- 3) drain sauerkraut and give it a quick rinse under water
- 4) add sauerkraut to bacon and onion
- 5) pour 2 bottles of lager over the mix and let simmer on bake in the oven for 1 hour
- 6) check from time to time to stir and add water if needed
- 7) bake till sauerkraut has a nice dark golden color

Serve with your favored meats or add sausage or other smoked meats to the sauerkraut and let it ad even more smoked flavor to the dish. Serve with Knödel, or mashed potato. Vielen Dank Iris Richardson
