Unsung Heroes of the American Revolution

Saturday, **April 30, 2016** at 3:00pm

Professor Robert A. Selig, renowned Colonial American history scholar, will speak at the DSB at 3:00pm on April 30 on the German Regiment that fought with General Rochambeau's French Army in support of Washington's troops in 1781. The unit was the Royal-Deux-Ponts. Few people realize that two armies marched through Delaware en route to Yorktown and camped at our own Cooch's Bridge. Judge Richard Cooch will make a special presentation from the Rochambeau family in Paris and Wade Catts, historical archeologist, will introduce Professor Selig. Everyone is invited to an interesting afternoon.

Sponsored by the DSB Culture Committee this event is an outreach program together with Bill Conley of the Pencader Heritage Assoc., and a consortium of Delaware Historical Groups including the W3R-DE, and the Delaware Alliance Francaise.
