A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PRESIDENT

Liebe Mitglieder - Dear Members,

The club is about to celebrate several important anniversaries. Fifty years ago the DSB was without a home, having lost its building in downtown Wilmington to urban renewal in 1965. In the Spring of 1967 the current property on Salem Church Road in Ogletown was acquired. The first club picnic on the new grounds was held on July 29, 1967. Members volunteered their labor to repair the house so it could be rented for income, and to convert the barn into the Bauernstube. The Bauernstube was dedicated on November 9, 1967. I have asked the Culture Committee to propose how we should celebrate this anniversary in November, and honor the members still living and the memory of those no longer with us, who performed the miracle that saved the club. Next year we will celebrate the fiftieth anniversary of the founding of the Enzian Volkstanzgruppe and the Ladies of the Delaware Saengerbund.

5-8 years old

Nordic myths and Viking tales

Read fascinating myths from the Norse world and tales of the Northmen, passed down by generations from tribespeople eventually settling in Germany and Northern Europe. Become inspired by magical creatures, longboats, and castles to create artworks out of many different craft materials. Present your creations proudly to parents and family members on the last day of camp.

9-15 years old

Get ready to learn craft techniques developed in the Middle Ages in the Byzantine Empire and during the Western Renaissance. Design and create a mosaic, weave, imitate stained glass techniques with translucent paper folding, develop intricate designs with paper quilling and carve your own printing plate out of linoleum, and walk in Gutenberg's and Dürer's shoes. As always we will also have plenty of smaller fun projects to choose from, and to fill our afternoons with fun and challenging art projects..

Camp will meet every day from **1:00 pm to 4:00 pm**. Lunch is noon to 1pm.

Kids need to bring their own lunch and afternoon snack.

Oktoberfest Committee

The Oktoberfest Committee is developing a master plan for the festival grounds in the area of the pavilion and newly acquired adjoining property. It will involve moving some existing fences and installing some permanent ones to eliminate the need for installing them each year. The intent is to move the existing truck access that crosses the soccer field and replace it with one behind the pavilion that would go to the back of the festival grounds. This will provide better access during wet weather for trucks delivering beverages and for trucks servicing the toilet area, and lessen damage to the field. This will allow us to move the admission tent over for straight in access for guests and to develop a dedicated food service aisle along the tent. We also plan to evaluate our electrical needs as well as add capability for a wireless network to service credit card transactions. If you have any ideas or input you would like to have considered please contact members of the Oktoberfest Committee.

August 21, 2017 at 7:30 p.m. in the Deutsche Halle – follow-up meeting to make final preparations for the festival. Committee Chairs should have worker lists prepared at this point so we can identify gaps.

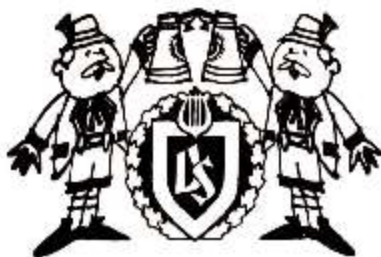
