2021 DSB Board of Directors Scholarship

Congratulations to **KARL SCHULZ** and **EMMA KUSKA** who received this year's Board of Directors' awards. They must have at least a 3.0 grade average, must provide a 25% German heritage and are planning to attend schools of higher education. Future high school seniors who fulfill these requirements are encouraged to apply.

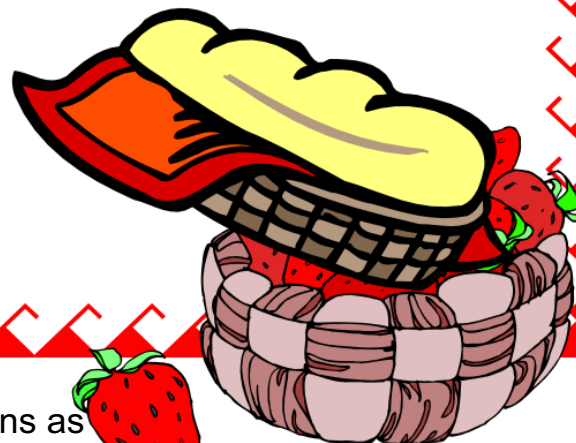
