DSB Summer Language Camp for Kids 2023: Deutsch macht Spass!





Please sign up your children (or grandchildren): From July 31 to August 11, 2023 (Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.)

We plan to have two Language classes this year separated by age, maturity and German language proficiency. The age range that we are looking for is ages 5-12. (We need to have some distribution flexibility to ensure each teacher has enough students; therefore, we cannot base our decision solely on age.) Teachers will be Iris Busch for children 9-12 and Caroline Dooley & Jayden Biesenbach for children 5-8.

Activities will include storytelling, singing, writing, and drawing to support the interactive learning experience. This year's theme for both classes will be German fairy tales which are rich in folklore and morality. Because the fairy tales are imaginative analogies of the inner development of humanity as a whole as well as that of the individual child, they are the best spiritual nourishment a child can possibly receive during the period of transition or awakening. The Brothers Grimm collected and popularized many of the tales, and they have become a staple on the world's bookcases.

Application deadline is June 30, 2023. First come, first served. <u>Classes fill up quickly</u>. Only 15 children per class for a total of 30 children. Questions?
