Garden Committee

The Garden committee has begun tagging plants and saplings for a pre-spring cleanup of certain garden areas. Please do not remove the orange tags or the plants without a garden committee member present. Small aluminum numbered tags have been purchased to mark the clubs special, native, important, memorial plantings. The intention is to make available a numbered list to catalog the plantings around the club. - Poison ivy and invasive vine removal.
- Spring perennial planting.
