Tommy Keith and Brian Schulz received the distinguished *Federal Republic of Germany Friendship Award* from the German Embassy. Ms. Anke Popper of the Embassy attended the EVTG's 50th Anniversary celebration and presented the awards to these two men.

This "dynamic duo" has served as leaders and ambassadors of the Enzian Volkstanzgruppe for many years. They grew up in this organization when their parents together with two other couples started the folk dancing group at the Delaware Saengerbund in 1968. They

were 8 and 5 years of age respectively when they began. They have become leaders and role models beyond this local society and selflessly offer their talents and time to those who are curious and perhaps somewhat unsure of their own skills and talents. They are outstanding representatives of dedication and commitment to preserving and sharing the German cultural heritage with the greater citizenry that is interested in learning more about this heritage.

November 11, 3:30 pm: Das Buch zum Film – Book and Movie

Erich Maria Remarque – *Im Westen nichts Neues*

To commemorate the end of the First World War, the movie *All Quiet on the Western Front* will be shown in the library on **Sunday, November 11 at 3:30pm** (In B/W, duration 2 hours 12 minutes. English language and subtitles, with introduction by film historian Robert Osborne).

The author, Erich Maria Remarque, drew on his own experience as an infantryman during the First World War as his inspiration for the novel titled *Im Westen nichts Neues*. Published in 1929, the book sold over one million copies in Germany within its first year. It became even more popular after being translated and published in other countries. Universal Studios owner Carl Laemmle immediately bought the movie rights and started filming the story in 1930. The film received Best Picture Academy Award and is still considered one of the most influential anti-war films ever made.

A reminder: Our library is set up as an **open** library, which means it is always open during regular club hours unless the library room is used for meetings. Saengerbund members may take any books from the shelves and keep them as long as they want. No signing out or signing in.
