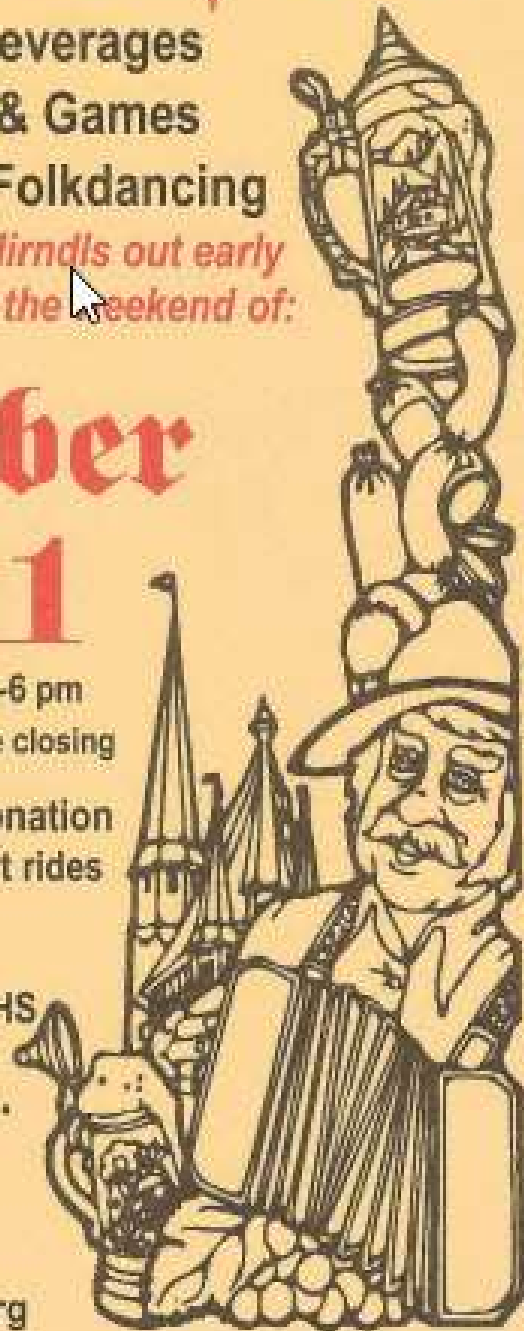

DSB Summer **Language** Camp for Kids 2022: **Deutsch macht Spass!**



Please sign up your children (or grandchildren):

From August 1 to August 12, 2022 (Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.)

We plan to have two Language classes this year separated by age, maturity and German language proficiency. The age range that we are looking for is ages 5-14. (We need to have some distribution flexibility to ensure each teacher has enough students; therefore, we cannot base our decision solely on age.) Teachers will be Iris Busch for children 10-14 & Christy Wall for children 5-9.

Activities will include storytelling, singing, writing, and drawing to support the interactive learning experience. The theme for both classes will be: "A World of Celebrations: Everyone Loves a Good Party." Year round, people in both Germany and the USA practice customs and traditions. These are important to the lives of individuals, families and the community at large. While some traditions are practiced in both countries, others are unique to the German-speaking countries. Activities will include: Fasching, Schuleinführung, St. Martinstag und Nikolaustag.

Application deadline is June 30, 2022. First come, first served. Classes fill up quickly. Only 15 children per class for a total of 30 children. Questions?
